

Value Chain Reporting as per SEBI Guidelines

For the current reporting period, as per definition provided by SEBI, the Company has included Tata Chemicals Limited as a part of its value chain disclosure requirement under the BRSR framework. Tata Chemicals Limited individually, accounts for 11% of procurement spend and 19.8% of total revenue of TCP for FY 2025-26.
