Independent Registered Auditor's Opinion

To the Shareholders' Meeting of Tata Global Beverages Polska Sp. z o.o.

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of Tata Global Beverages Polska Sp. z o.o. (hereinafter called "the Company"), Klobucka 25 Street, Warsaw, which comprise the introduction to the financial statements; the balance sheet as at 31 March 2015, showing total assets and total equity and liabilities of PLN 13,735,581.43, the income statement for the year from 1 April 2014 to 31 March 2015, showing a net loss of PLN 8,646,511.02, the statement of changes in equity, the cash flow statement for the financial year and additional notes and explanations.

The Company's Management Board is responsible for preparing the financial statements and Directors' Report in accordance with the applicable regulations, and for the correctness of the accounting records. Members of the Management Board of the Company are obliged to ensure that the financial statements and the Director's Report comply with the requirements of the Accounting Act of 29 September 1994 ("the Accounting Act" – Journal of Laws of 2013, item 330 as amended).

Our responsibility was to perform an audit of the accompanying financial statements and to express an opinion on whether the financial statements comply in all material respects with the applicable accounting policies and whether they present, in all material respects, a true and clear view of the Company's financial position and its financial results, and whether the accounting records constituting the basis for their preparation are properly maintained.

We conducted our audit in accordance with:

- a. the provisions of Chapter 7 of the Accounting Act;
- b. national standards of auditing issued by the National Council of Registered Auditors.

Our audit was planned and performed to obtain reasonable assurance that the financial statements were free of material misstatements and omissions. The audit included examining, on a test basis, evidence—supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The audit also included assessing the accounting policies applied by the Company and significant estimates made in the preparation of the financial statements, as well as overall assessment of their presentation. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

In our opinion, and in all material respects, the accompanying financial statements:

- a. give a fair and clear view of the Company's financial position as at 31 March 2015 and of the financial results for the year from 1 April 2014 to 31 March 2015, in accordance with the accounting polices binding in Poland as specified in the Accounting Act;
- b. comply in terms of form and content with the applicable laws and the Company's Articles of Association;
- c. have been prepared on the basis of properly maintained books of account, in accordance with the applicable accounting policies.

The information contained in the Directors' Report for the year from 1 April 2014 to 31 March 2015 has been presented in accordance with the provisions of the Accounting Act and is consistent with the information contained in the audited financial statements.

Without qualifying our opinion on the truth and fairness of the audited financial statements, we draw attention to the fact that the financial statements were prepared using a going concern principle. As presented in the Company's balance sheet, sum of the net loss for the period from 1 April 2014 to 31 March 2015 and for the previous periods amounting total PLN 59,092,168.73 exceeded sum of the share and supplementary capital. In a such situation, the Company's Management Board, in accordance with the provisions of Art. 233 of the Commercial Companies Code, is obliged to immediately convene the Shareholders' Meeting in order to adopt a resolution regarding the Company's continued existence. By the date of signing the registered auditor's opinion, an appropriate resolution had not been adopted.

Moreover the Company's liabilities as of 31 March 2015 exceeded Company's total assets by PLN 15,228,897.60. This indicates the existence of an uncertainty which cast significant doubt about the Company's ability to continue as a going concern.

In point 2 of the Introduction to the financial statements the Management Board presented its position with relation to the financing of the Company through obtaining from the related entity a support letter ensuring its willingness to support the Company for the next 13 months from the date of this support letter (20 April 2015). Without such support application of the going concern principle may be not appropriate.

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Introduction to the financial statements

as at and for the financial year from 1 April 2014 to 31 March 2015

1. The Company's core business activity

Tata Global Beverages Polska Sp. z o.o., Warsaw, ul. Kłobucka 25, began operating in 1994. The Company was entered in the Register of Businesses maintained by the District Court in Warsaw, the 20th Business Department of the National Court Register, with the reference number KRS 30868. At present, the Company is registered with the 13th Business Department of the National Court Register. The Company's core business operations comprise mainly wholesale trading in teas and other food products.

In the period from 1 April 2014 to 31 March 2015 the Management Board comprised: Nigel Holland and Manesh Thakrar.

As stated in the Articles of Association, the duration of the Company is unlimited.

2. Financial statements

The accounting policies used in the preparation of the financial statements comply with the Accounting Act of 29 September 1994 (Journal of Laws of 2013, item 330, as amended) and other secondary legislation issued on its basis, hereinafter called "the Act", which determines, among others, the general accounting principles to be applied by entities having their registered office or seat of management in the Republic of Poland.

Accounting entries are made on the historical cost basis.

The financial statements cover the period of 12 months from 1 April 2014 to 31 March 2015. The comparative data is presented for the corresponding period of the previous accounting year.

All amounts presented in the financial statements are in PLN.

The above-mentioned accounting policies were applied both in the financial year ended 31 March 2015 and in the financial year ended 31 March 2014.

The financial statements have been prepared based on the assumption that the Company will continue in operation as a going concern. In the current financial year the Company incurred a net loss of PLN 8,646,511.02. The Company's net assets as at 31 March 2015 were negative and amounted to PLN (15,228,897.60).

The Company received a letter from Tata Global Beverages GB Limited of 20 April 2015 which guaranteed financing for a period of at least 13 months from the date thereof.

Due to the above, even though the Company's equity recognized in the balance sheet shows that the Company's liabilities exceed its assets, the financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis.

Moreover, pursuant to Resolution no. 6 of the Annual General Shareholders' Meeting of Tata Global Beverages Polska Sp. z o.o. passed on 28 July 2014 in accordance with Art. 233 of the Commercial Companies Code, on the basis of data from the financial statements for the period from 1 April 2013 to 31 March 2014 and data from the Directors' Report, it was resolved that Tata Global Beverages Polska Sp. z o.o. would continue in operation.

3. Adopted accounting policies

(a) Tangible fixed assets and intangible assets

Fixed assets comprise non-current assets and their equivalents, fit for use and intended for the Company's own use.

Intangible assets comprise property rights used by the entity to conduct business activities, with an anticipated economic useful life in excess of one year.

Intangible assets are stated at cost of purchase less accumulated amortization and impairment write-downs.

Tangible fixed assets are stated in the financial statements at the net book value, i.e. at cost less accumulated depreciation and impairment write-downs. The cost of fixed assets comprises the total costs incurred by the entity during the period of their construction, assembly, improvement and adaptation for use, including non-recoverable VAT and the cost of liabilities incurred less the related income.

Impairment is recognized when there is a high probability that an asset controlled by the Company will not render, in the future, a significant portion or all of the expected economic benefits. In the event of earmarking a given asset for

scrapping, discontinuing its use or other reasons which give rise to impairment of such a fixed asset, a write-down is recognized as part of other operating expenses.

Amortization/depreciation is charged based on the current amortization/depreciation plan, which defines the rates and amounts of annual amortization/depreciation charges for the individual categories of non-current assets, taking into account the useful lives of the individual components of non-current assets. Depreciation/ amortization is recognized on a straight-line basis. Depreciation/ amortization is charged starting from the month following the month in which a given fixed asset or intangible asset was commissioned for use.

The correctness of the economic useful lives and other data adopted in the depreciation/amortization schedule is periodically verified by the entity's manager, resulting in an appropriate adjustment of the annual rates and amounts of charges beginning from the first month of the subsequent financial year.

Annual depreciation rates for the principal categories of fixed assets are as follows:

buildings, apartments (leasehold improvements) - 10% - 10%-30% vehicles - 20% other tangible fixed assets - 20%

The amortization rate for intangible assets, which comprise computer software and copyrights, is 20% - 50%. The Company uses the 20% annual rate for amortization of goodwill. Goodwill amortization is recognized in "Other operating expenses / other" in the income statement.

Fixtures and fittings with a value lower than PLN 1,000 are not recognized; they are charged to the income statement directly as the costs of materials used.

(b) Receivables

Receivables are valued as at the balance sheet date at amounts due, including accrued default interest, and carried net of write-downs.

Receivables are revalued based on the likelihood of their receipt by recognizing impairment write-downs, which are charged to other operating expenses or financial costs depending on the type of the receivable.

Taxation, subsidy, and social insurance receivables and other receivables are stated at amounts due in accordance with the law, contract or other documents.

(c) Inventories

Inventories are valued at the lower of the actual purchase price or the actual cost of manufacture and net realizable value.

The cost of purchase is the actual purchase price of materials, comprising the amount due to the seller (net of VAT) and in the case of imports, comprising charges to the State Budget and costs directly related to the purchase, including transport, loading and unloading costs, less any price reductions (rebates, discounts).

Inventory write-downs recorded due to impairment and resulting from valuation at the net realizable value instead of the cost of purchase or manufacture are charged to other operating expenses.

(d) Monetary assets

Monetary assets comprise cash in hand, cash at bank, cash deposits payable within three months, cheques, bills of exchange and similar instruments payable within three months of their issue. Monetary assets also include accrued interest on financial assets.

Cash and cash equivalents are measured at the nominal value and stated including (or less) interest.

Interest received and receivable is recognized as financial income.

(e) Prepayments and accruals

i. Prepayments and deferred costs

Prepayments and deferred costs comprise costs which relate to the periods following the period in which they were incurred. The timing and method of recognition in the income statement corresponds to the nature of the expenses recognized, taking account of the prudence principle.

ii. Accruals

Accruals referred to in Art. 39.2.2 of the Act are presented in equity and liabilities under "Provisions for liabilities". In particular:

- accruals relating to all kinds of employee benefits, e.g. holiday pay, annual bonuses, long service bonuses, retirement bonuses are presented under "Provisions for employee benefits and similar items", with the exception of salaries and wages for the preceding financial year accrued but not paid, which are presented under salaries and wages payable;
- accruals relating to future benefits to persons other than employees whose amount can be estimated reliably, even though the date of origin of the liability is not yet known, e.g. provisions for guarantee repairs, restructuring provisions, are presented under "Other provisions".

Accruals referred to in Art. 39.2.1. of the Act (mainly goods and services received, but not invoiced) are presented in the liabilities under "Trade payables" in accordance with the Polish Accounting Standard no. 6.

(f) Equity

Equity comprises share capital, supplementary capital and reserves recorded by the Company in accordance with the binding regulations, the Company's Articles of Association and the resolution of the General Shareholders' Meeting, including the amount resulting from retained earnings/accumulated losses.

The Company's share capital is shown in the amount specified in the notarial deed and the entry in the commercial register, at nominal value.

Capital contributions declared but not made are recognized as share capital not paid up.

Should the shareholders pass a resolution specifying the date and amount of capital contributions, their equivalent is recorded as a separate item in the balance sheet (capital contributions reserve) and shown in equity until utilized in a manner justifying its write-off. Capital contributions enacted but not made are shown as capital contributions due (negative amount).

Supplementary capital comprises the share premium, other amounts added in accordance with the binding regulations or the notarial deed and net profit transferred to the supplementary capital in accordance with a resolution of the General Shareholders' Meeting.

Retained earnings/ accumulated losses comprise profit and losses from previous years, which have not been appropriated or offset in accordance with the resolutions of the General Shareholders' Meeting.

(g) Provisions for liabilities

Provisions for liabilities are stated at valid, reliably estimated amounts.

Provisions are recognized against certain or probable future liabilities, whose amount may be reliably estimated, in particular against losses on pending business, including those related to guarantees, warranties granted, loans and the outcome of litigation in progress.

Provisions are charged to other operating expenses, financial costs or extraordinary losses, depending on the circumstances of future liabilities.

(h) Liabilities

Financial liabilities are measured not later than as at the end of the reporting period at the adjusted purchase price. Liabilities other than financial are stated at amounts due, inclusive of interest payable as at the balance sheet date. This interest is charged to financial costs.

(i) Foreign currency transactions

Assets and liabilities expressed in foreign currencies are recognized as at the balance sheet date at the mid exchange rate announced by the National Bank of Poland for a given currency as at that date.

During the year, the Company recognizes transactions expressed in foreign currencies, which relate to:

- cash and cash equivalents, receipt of receivables and payment of liabilities at the buying or selling rate of the Company's bank;
- receivables and liabilities at the mid exchange rate determined for a given currency by the President of the National Bank of Poland as at the day preceding the transaction date, unless the customs clearance document provides a different rate.

Foreign exchange gains/losses arising on the payment or at the balance sheet date are charged or credited to financial costs or income, or, if justified, to the cost of manufacture of finished goods or cost of purchase of goods for resale, or the cost of purchase or manufacture of fixed assets, fixed assets under construction or intangible assets.

(j) Sales

Sales revenue is recognized at the time the goods are delivered, if the entity transferred significant risks and benefits resulting from ownership rights to the goods, or at the time services are provided. Sales are recognized net of VAT, any discounts granted and any costs of marketing services provided by the Company's customers, which are aimed at intensifying sales, irrespective of the manner of calculating such costs.

(k) Mandatory appropriation of profit

Mandatory profit appropriations comprise corporate income tax charged in accordance with the CIT Act and other equivalent payments arising from other regulations.

Corporate income tax is calculated on the basis of profit before tax determined in accordance with the accounting regulations, adjusted for non-taxable income, non-deductible costs and deductions relating to accumulated losses, investment relief and donations.

The Company recognizes deferred tax provisions and deferred tax assets in respect of temporary differences between the carrying values of assets or liabilities and their tax bases, and tax losses carried forward.

Deferred tax assets are determined at the amount of corporate income tax recoverable in the future in respect of deductible temporary differences and the carryforward of tax losses, taking account of the prudence principle.

A deferred tax provision is recognized at the amount of corporate income tax payable in the future in respect of taxable temporary differences, i.e. differences which result in a higher tax base in the future.

Deferred tax provisions and assets are measured at the tax rates applicable in the year in which the related tax obligation arises.

A deferred tax expense or income is recognized in the income statement representing the difference between deferred tax provisions and assets as at the beginning and end of a given reporting period, excluding deferred tax provisions or assets that are credited or charged to equity in line with the treatment of the transactions to which they relate.

4. Change in the presentation of the financial statements

In the financial year ended 31 March 2015, the Company did not make any changes to its accounting policies in relation to the previous year, which would have a significant effect on the Company's financial position and results of operations.

The Board of Directors hereby presents the Directors' Report and financial result for the financial year ended 31 March 2015.

INTRODUCTION

Tata Global Beverages Polska Sp. z o.o. ("TGBP") was formed on the basis of a notarial deed prepared in the Notary Public's Office of Czesława Kołcun on 04 February 1994 (Rep. A-1100/94).

The Company was registered on 21 March 1994, under the reference number RHB 39908 with the business name Lyons Tetley Poland Sp. z o.o. The Company obtained the statistical number REGON 010611629. In 1995, the name was changed to Tetley Polska Sp. z o.o. On 27 July 2010, the name was changed to its current one.

On 27 July 2001 the Company was entered in the Register of Businesses maintained by the District Court in Warsaw, XXth Business Division of the National Court Register under the reference number KRS 30868.

On 31 March 2015, the Company's Management Board comprised Nigel Holland and Manesh Thakrar.

As of 31 March 2015 the Company's share capital amounts to PLN 43,859,400 and is composed of 73,099 shares with a nominal value of PLN 600 each. The sole shareholder of TGBP is Tata Global Beverages Overseas Holdings Limited, Great Britain.

The Company's seat is located in Warsaw, Kłobucka Street 25. The company has no other branches.

OPERATIONS

In the 2014/15 financial year, TGBP continued its operations consisting of sales of tea under Tetley, Vitax and Flosana brands as well as syrups under Vitax brand.

The Polish retail market remains very competitive, with a growing private label segment in practically all categories, including tea. It is expected that the level of competition will not change significantly going forward. The retail environment over the last few years has seen a lot of change and consolidation. Foreign retail outlets are changing the face of the trade in Poland, and with these changes come certain benefits and challenges for the players in the tea category. TGBP is well placed to take advantage of such an environment with its vast modern trade expertise.

The Company does not conduct research and development activities.

EMPLOYEES

In the financial year the average TGBP employment was 87.

FINANCIAL SITUATION

The Company's financial statements for the period from 1 April 2014 to 31 March 2015 were prepared in accordance with the binding regulations.

In the financial year the net sales have decreased by 8,7% in comparison to prior year. The financial result shows loss of PLN 8 646 511.02. Net equity as at 31 March 2015 was negative and amounted to PLN 15 228 897.60.

The Company has received a letter from Tata Global Beverages GB Limited dated 20 April 2015 confirming financial support for the Company for at least 13 months from the letter date. Due to this and despite the negative equity the financial statements were prepared on the going concern basis.

As at the end of the year the main source of financing for the company was a loan granted by Tata Global Beverages Overseas Holdings Limited and a bank overdraft facility with HSBC Bank Polska S.A.

SOURCES OF REVENUE

The main source of revenue in the financial year was sales of tea and syrups to clients in traditional and modern trade channels.

FINANCIAL RISK MANAGEMENT

TGBP is subject to currency, interest fluctuation risk and customer credit risk. Management Board does not identify any other significant financial risks.

CAPITAL EXPENDITURE

In the financial year, TGBP's capital expenditure was limited to purchase of electronic equipment and equipment to the new office.

EXPECTED BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT

In future, TGBP expects to reinforce presence in the Polish beverage market as part of the Tata Global Beverages Group.

The following comments are based on information obtained during the audit of the financial statements.

- At the end of the financial year, the Company's total assets amounted to PLN 13,736 thousand. During the year total assets decreased by PLN 1,334 thousand, i.e. by 8,9%.
 The decrease in total assets is mainly due to the net loss incurred in amount of PLN 8,647 thousand, while the balance of short-term liabilities increased by PLN 7,268 thousand.
- Total equity as at 31 March 2015 was negative and amounted to PLN 15,229 thousand. A decrease of total equity by PLN 8,647 thousand (i.e. by 132.4%) was mainly due to the net loss incurred by the Company.
- Short-term liabilities as at 31 March 2015 amounted to PLN 27,940 thousand and comprised mainly trade paybles of PLN 22,557 thousand (including trade paybles to related entities of PLN 15,772 thousand) and other short-term liabilities to related etities of PLN 5,000 thousand. The PLN 7,268 thousand increase in short-term liabilities compared with the previous year resulted mainly from an increase in the balance of trade payables to related entities of PLN 5,084 thousand and an increase in the balance of other libialities to related entities of PLN 1,650 thousand.
- Liability ratios and the structure of liabilities have changed. The gearing ratio increased from 144% at the end of the previous year to 211% at the end of the audited year. The payables turnover ratio increased from 142 days to 165 days, respectively. The changes were mainly due to the additional loan granted by a related entity in the amount of PLN 1,650 thousand.
- Total sales amounted to PLN 36,119 thousand. Such sales have decreased by PLN 3,444 thousand, i.e. by 8.7% compared with the previous financial year. This decrease was mainly due to a decrease in the volume of goods for resale sold. The Company's core activities in the audited financial year consisted of sales of tea and other groceries.
- The cost of goods for resale and materials sold was the largest item of operating expenses and amounted to PLN 22,284 thousand in the audited year, which constituted 50.0% of operating expenses. The cost of goods for resale and materials sold has decreased by PLN 1,343 thousand, i.e. by 5.7% compared with the previous year, mainly due to the decrease in sales.
- Profitability measured with net profit was negative and amounted to 24% and was 5 percentage points lower than in the previous year.



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III. The Company's results, financial position and significant items of financial statements (cont.)

• The Company's liquidity has changed. At the end of the audited year, the current and quick ratios, which amounted to 0.5 (as at the end of the previous period: 0.7) and 0.3 (as at the end of the previous period: 0.5) respectively, decreased mainly due to the the increase in short-term liabilities.

The financial statements have been prepared on the assumption that the Company will continue in operations as a going concern.

The balance sheet prepared by the Company shows a net loss for the period from 1 April 2014 to 31 March 2015 and accumulated losses in the total amount of PLN 59,092,168.73. This amount exceeds the sum of total share and supplementary capital. In such circumstances, pursuant to the provisions of Art. 233 of the Commercial Companies Code, the Company's Management Board is obliged to summon the General Shareholders' Meeting immediately in order to pass a resolution on the Company's further existence. By the date of signing the Registered Auditor's Opinion, such resolution had not been passed.

The Company's liabilities and provisions for liabilities as of 31 March 2015 exceeded Company's total assets by PLN 15,228,897.60. This indicates the existence of an uncertainty which cast significant doubt about the Company's ability to continue as a going concern.

Note 2 of the Introduction to the financial statements contains the Management Board's declaration as to the sources of financing, which include a written assurance of the Company's related entity on its intention to provide financing to the Company for a period of 13 months from the date of the letter (20 April 2015). Without such support, application of the going concern principle may be not appropriate.

- a. The independent registered auditor's statementThe Management Board of the Company provided all the information, explanations, and representations requested in the course of the audit and provided a representation letter confirming the completeness of the data included in the accounting records and the disclosure of all contingent liabilities and post balance-sheet events which occurred up to the date on which that letter was signed.
- b. The scope of the audit was not limited.
- c. The Company has up-to-date documentation of its accounting policies, approved by the Management Board. The Company's accounting policies were tailored to its needs and ensured the recognition of all events having a material effect on the assessment of its financial position and results, taking into consideration the prudence principle. There were no changes to the accounting policies compared with the previous year.
- d. The closing balances as at the end of the previous year were correctly brought forward as the opening balances of the current financial year in all material respects.
- e. The stocktaking of assets and liabilities were carried out and reconciled in accordance with the Accounting Act, and the results were included in the accounting records for the audited year.
- f. The financial statements of the Company for the year from 1 April 2013 to 31 March 2014 were approved by Resolution No. 3 passed by the Shareholders' Meeting on 28 July 2014 and filed with the National Court Register in Warsaw on 28 July 2014.
- g. In accordance with the Resolution No. 2 of the Shareholders' Meeting of 28 July 2014, the net loss for the prior year of PLN 7,498 thousand will be covered by the Company's profits in the following years.
- h. The financial statements for the previous financial year were audited by PricewaterhouseCoopers Sp. z o.o. The registered auditor issued an opinion with an explanatory paragraph.
- i. We have assessed the operation of the accounting system. Our assessment covered in particular:
 - the accuracy of the documentation relating to business transactions;
 - the fairness, accuracy and verifiability of the books of account, including computerised books of account;
 - the methods used for controlling access to data and the computerised data processing system;
 - the safeguarding of the accounting documentation, books of account, and financial statements.

This assessment, together with our verification of individual items of the financial statements, provides the basis for expressing an overall and comprehensive opinion on

these financial statements. The audit was not intended to provide a comprehensive opinion on the operations of the said system.

- j. The notes to the financial statements, which include the introduction and additional notes and explanations, present all the significant information specified in the Accounting Act.
- k. The Directors' Report for the year from 1 April 2014 to 31 March 2015 includes all the information required by the Accounting Act. The financial information presented therein is consistent with that presented in the financial statements.



V. Final information

This report has been prepared in connection with our audit of the financial statements of Tata Global Beverages Polska Sp. z o.o., Kłobucka 25 Street, Warsaw. The financial statements were signed by the Company's Management Board and the person preparing the financial statements on 30 April 2015.

This report should be read in conjunction with the Independent Registered Auditor's Opinion with explanatory paragraph to the Shareholders' Meeting of Tata Global Beverages Polska Sp. z o.o. dated 30 April 2015, concerning the said financial statements. The opinion on the financial statements expresses a general conclusion drawn from the audit and involves assessing the materiality of individual audit findings rather than being a sum of all the evaluations of individual financial statement components. This assessment takes account of the impact of the facts noted on the truth and fairness of the financial statements as a whole.
